## Data in Head Start and Early Head Start

- Help all employees to be enthusiastic about using data.
- How to use your program's data to decide on new priorities.
- Share Data appropriately with different audiences and show how each audience can use the information.
- Celebrate the good news that data shows and learn from the bad news so you can improve your program.



# Plan to Succeed: Program Planning



- Do your current systems support data use?
- Ongoing monitoring system that will ensure good-quality data is collected and progress is able to be tracked.
- Communication system.
- Data shapes goal setting for the program.
- What is the purpose of the data collection?
- Self-Assessment enables a good look at each component's use of data and how to drive change.






# Dig into Data

What can be put in place to change the outcome?




Consistent follow up to ensure action plans are efficient and/or productive.



## Head Start Early Learning Outcomes Framework




Describes skills, behaviors, and knowledge that programs must foster in ALL children.





Aligning instruction and opportunities for play, exploration, discovery, and problem-solving with the early learning outcomes described in the Framework will promote successful learning in all children.




